6 QUESTIONS TO ASK WHEN MAKING DECISIONS

WHO

Who should speak into this decision?

The way of a fool seems right to him, but a wise man listens to advice. (PROVERBS 12:15)

WHAT

What are the facts?

To answer before listening -- that is folly and shame.

(PROVERBS 18:13)

WHEN

When do you need a decision?

Desire without knowledge is not good -- how much more will hasty feet miss the way! (PROVERBS 19:2)

WHY

Why do you want to?

All a person's ways seem pure to them, but motives are weighed by the Lord.

(PROVERBS 16:2)

WHERE

Where do the scriptures speak to this?

Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to Him, and He will make your paths straight.

(PROVERBS 3:5-6)

HOW

How will God be glorified in this decision?

So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God (1 CORINTHIANS 10:31)
